Digital access, inclusion and equity for health for MELAA women

Provide a short summary of the work that was completed as part of this initiative.

This project explored digital health access, inclusion, and equity for women from Middle Eastern, Latin American and African (MELAA) communities. The proposed research was completed with the findings providing a stepping stone to better understanding the challenges women from these communities have accessing the internet to support their health and identifying opportunities for advancing digital health in Aotearoa New Zealand (hereafter Aotearoa NZ).

The project had three arms.

- The first arm was a scoping review of the literature exploring how women from different ethnic groups in Aotearoa NZ, access and utilise digital health technologies, a relatively understudied area. The protocol for this scoping review has been published, and a draft of the findings from the review is being prepared.
- The second arm aimed to explore this topic further with stakeholders from the health sector and community organisations working with women from MELAA communities in Auckland. Ten participants were interviewed in these key informant interviews.
- The third arm aimed to include the voices and experiences of women from MELAA communities. 13 women participated in the prepared focus group discussions.

A summary report outlining the key findings will be shared with stakeholders at a community and stakeholder dissemination hui. The findings from this project will contribute to the preparation of two journal articles to be submitted in peer-reviewed journals. They will also be submitted to the Centre for Asian and Ethnic Migrant Health Research Symposium in Auckland in September 2024 and the Digital Health Week in Hamilton in December 2024.
